WFUNA UN SPOTLIGHT SEMINARS (IN-COUNTRY)

Concept:

WFUNA offers to organize, for selected Universities, a Seminar within their precincts. WFUNA provides the trainers, the material and sets up a full program for the Seminar that can last from one to two weeks. Besides the lectures, it involves participatory classes and workshops as well as a role-play where participants will be given the opportunity to apply the acquired knowledge (e.g.: organization of a mock-COP Climate Summit). The entire seminar is conceived as linked to the regular classes that students follow in their University and aims to provide them with tools and perspectives complementary to their curriculum.

Proposal:

WFUNA proposes a series of Seminars exclusive to the members of AUAP. An interested institution will be offered to sign an agreement with WFUNA. Each of these agreements will follow the main aspects outlined below.

Duration of the program: 6 days of courses (can include weekends upon agreement)

Theme: There are three tracks to choose from for each program: Peace and Security, Sustainable Development and Human Rights. For each theme, UN experts will participate to train University students in the chosen track.

Available dates: February to June and September to December.

Location: within University precincts

Age range: Undergraduate or postgraduate students accepted.

Content:

Trainers sent by WFUNA to the University will cover all subjects agreed upon and lead lectures, innovative group activities, and role-plays on related subjects. Additional components can be added upon agreement. In particular, project cycle management sessions in view of the establishment of a small project in link with subject of training can be added.

Pre-training online courses can be offered.
